

Mold Remediation



Certified, Professional Remediation When Mold Gets Out of Control

When a property has been affected by moisture, in circumstances such as a leak or flood, or even sustained high humidity, mold spores, which are virtually everywhere waiting to germinate, will grow. Water in buildings can create absolutely ideal conditions for growth.

Mold requires three conditions to grow: moisture, temperature and a food source. Indoor relative humidity over 60% is the danger zone for mold growth. When mold spreads from one wall to the next, or from carpet to walls, a full-scale remediation becomes necessary. Improper handling of widespread mold can further spread mold leading to more damage.

The certified process Stanley Steemer uses to remediate a property of widespread mold is to remove the spores from the structure, not just kill them. This is necessary as the allergic threat posed by mold is not removed when the spores are killed. The process involves setting up containment in the affected areas, setting up a negative air pressure and filtering the air with air scrubbers as the work is done. First, the mold is HEPA vacuumed, then it is either hand sanded, media blasted or wiped off the surfaces and anything that becomes airborne will be collected by the high power HEPA filter air scrubbers.

When the process is done, the structure is clean and the air is free of widespread spores. Following the remediation, steps need to be taken to be sure the cause of the moisture is corrected so the problem does not reoccur.
